| SEEDING | Both the interval start and mass start skiers in the Masters categories and Bantam Boy/Girl and younger categories will not be seeded. They will be grouped according to their age category and their positions determined by a random draw procedure. Mass start will use Canada Points List for the draw for Midget through Open age categories, so the leading points holder is at the front of the chevron start. | | | | |
| | There will be no seeding for categories that do not require a racing license (e.g., Bantam and younger). Order of start will be by random draw. | | | | |
| REFUNDS | A refund of individual registration fees will only be provided for medical reasons and if the competition secretary receives notification, WITH medical documentation, prior to the registration deadline. | | | | |

| BIB PICK-UP | Bibs for each day of racing will be distributed to each team from the Race Office upon opening of race office. | | | | |
| AWARDS | Teck, a diversified resource company based in BC, is the title sponsor of the BC Cup series. Teck provides the awards for ages 15 and under. All Atoms will receive a special Teck participant ribbon. Awards for ages 16 and over will be provided by Hollyburn. Awards ceremony will occur directly after each day of racing. | | | | |

| CONCESSION | There is a full service café at the WOP Day Lodge. | | | | |
| FACILITIES | The Flex Space at the race site will be available to athletes as shelter. There are toilets there as well but several portable toilets will also be located close to the stadium area. | | | | |
| TRAIL FEES | Trail fees are included in race fees for athletes and coaches. This will be processed at the WOP gate, with athletes' names and use of trail pass or annual pass. | | | | |
| WAX FACILITIES | A limited number of electrical outlets are available outside the Technical Building for waxing irons. There are also a limited number of wax trailers are available for rent at Whistler Olympic Park for \$35 plus taxes per day. | WAX TESTING | Wax testing on course is allowed up to 5 minutes before the first racer departs. | | | | |
| GLIDE WAX PROTOCO | L Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, athletes, wax technicians and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for identified races taking place in | | | | |

British Columbia. This also applies to coaches, athletes, wax technicians and parents traveling to British Columbia from out-of-province or out-of-country.

This protocol does not extend to national-level events held in British Columbia (e.g., NorAms and Western Canadian Championships). Waxing restrictions at those events (if any) are determined by the race organizers in consultation with Cross Country Canada.

Low-fluoro glide waxing protocol:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted.
- Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted.
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquids) are NOT permitted.
- Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted.

The above low-fluoro waxing protocol applies to the following races/age categories:

• At local races (i.e., club races, loppets, etc.): the low-fluoro protocol applies to Midget and younger age categories.

• At Regional Cup races (Coast Cup, Okanagan Cup, Kootenay Cup, Northern Cup): the low-fluoro protocol applies to ALL age categories.

• At BC Midget Championships and BC Winter Games: the low-fluoro protocol applies to ALL age categories.

• At BC Cup races (including the BC Championships) that are not combined with a NorAm or CCC/Canada Games selection races: the low-fluoro protocol applies to ALL age categories.

Notes:

If an athlete chooses to "race up" and compete in a different age category, the athlete is governed by the low-fluoro protocol in place for the category into which he/she races up.
 For BC Winter Games Trials, whether the race is a stand-alone trials or part of a bigger event, the low-fluoro protocol must as a minimum include athletes in the Juvenile and younger categories.

The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, athletes, parents and wax technicians.

RACE DISTANCES AND FEES

All three events will be integrated. By registering for the BC Cup event, you will automatically be registered in the other events if you qualify based on your club, age or city you live in. The races are the same for all three events and points will be calculated for the Coast Cup events and winners selected for the 2018 BC Winter Games for each zone (3, 4 or 5) based on the qualifying criteria for those events. However, we will not produce separate results for the Coast Cup races or Games Trials; there will only be results posted for the BC Cup #1 races.

Those born in 2003 or 2004 are eligible for the BC Winter Games Trials.
