ELIGIBILITY Skiers must be a member in good standing of a NC/CCBC club. If necessary, entrants

may sign up online as members with the Hollyburn Cross Country Ski Club

This race is designed to appeal to racers of all levels, from children and their

parents just starting out to advanced racers.

RESTRICTIONS EVENT AREA <u>Due to COVID-19 restrictions, spectators are not permitted in the stadium area or field of play during the event.</u>

The event area (stadium area, race and warm up trails) will be separated by fencing from the recreational ski trails and day lodge. Only participants who have registered for the event are permitted in the event areas. "Participants" include athletes, coaches

and team support personnel as well as event officials and volunteers.

Non-participants (e.g., family, friends) are welcome to ski on Whistler Olympic Park

recreational trails. Link to WOP trail pass purchase.

LICENCES No race license is required

RACE REGISTRATION

For COVID tracing purposes, all race participants will be required to register

("participants" = all racers, officials, coaches and support staff including wax techs,

drivers, etc.) Registration is only through Zone 4

All participants are required to complete the mandatory Participant Agreement during Zone 4 registration. As a result, registration will be restricted to one entry per cart.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS A detailed COVID Safety Plan can be found here: hollyburnxc.ca. It is essential that all race participants read the plan carefully and fully understand it ("participants" = all racers, officials, coaches and support staff including wax techs, drivers, etc.)

Please note that, due to the rapidly evolving nature of COVID-19, requirements may change at any time. Please consult the event website regularly for notices regarding changes.

Participants will be required to fill out the <u>Participant Agreement</u> as part of the Zone 4 registration as well as agree to complete the <u>Self-Assessment Tool</u> prior to arriving to the venue.

Those who do not comply with the plan will be required to leave and not participate further in the event.

Key points:

- All race participants are required to register on Zone4.
- Daily online pre-screening is required by all participants
- Only essential team staff should be on site. Spectating is strongly discouraged.
- Athletes should arrive ready to ski their warm up and leave immediately after their cool down.
- No indoor spaces are available to racers. The day lodge will be off limits to participants. Athletes should be in team vehicles if they need to stay on site.
- Wax rooms are for coaches and support staff only with occupancy limits and masks required.
- No food services provided.

FACILITIES

PARKING

WAXING

A limited number of electrical outlets are available outside the Technical Building for waxing irons. Waxing trailers are available for rent at Whistler Olympic Park at a rate of \$40 per day. **Please** contact the <u>Race Office</u> for wax cabin requests.

WARM UP

A warm up area will be available in the vicinity of the race start.

WAX TESTING

CCBC Protocol Regarding the Use of Fluorinated Waxes

Cross Country BC has adopted a No Fluoro policy for all age categories at all Teck Regional Cup races, please see **CCBC Non-fluoro Waxing Protocol**.

Non-fluoro waxing protocol applies to all ages for Coast Cup:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Non-fluoro (NF) waxes ARE permitted.
- Fluorinated waxes (excluding grip waxes) or tuning products containing fluorine liquid) are NOT permitted. This includes all types of fluorinated glide wax (e.g., LF, HF, block, powder, liquid)

COURSES

CONCESSION
