ELIGIBILITY Skiers must be a member in good standing of a NC/CCBC club. If necessary, entrants

may sign up online as members with the Hollyburn Cross Country Ski Club.

REGISTRATION

Credit card payment is required. E-mail confirmation after registration will be

sent if registered correctly.

DEADLINE Entries Deadline Wednesday, December 14, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. (midnight)

No late entries will be accepted.

TRAIL FEES All racers must have a Whister Olympic Park (WOP) trail pass for the day of the race.

These are <u>not</u> included in your race registration fee but can be purchased at an event

discount fee during race registration. Skiers with a WOP pass will not need to purchase a day pass but will need it to gain entry to the Park.

CANCELLATION

Any advance cancellation of the event will be by Cross Country BC in consultation with the organizing committee.

A decision to cancel the competition, or races for specific age categories due to the race conditions during an event will be made by the Chief of Competition in consultation with the race organizers.

REFUND POLICY

In the occurrence of cancellation by race organizers, a refund of registration fees less administration and event expenses already incurred will be provided post-event. No refunds will be made if an athlete does not participate in race(s).

ZONE4 online booking fees are non-refundable.

WAX PROTOCOL

CCBC Protocol Regarding the Use of Fluorinated Waxes is available here.

Non-fluoro waxing protocol applies to all ages for Coast Cup:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- CCBC Non-fluoro Waxing Protocol Fluoro kick waxes ARE permitted (but not fluoro grip powders).
- Identified non-fluoro (NF) glide waxes ARE permitted.

Adherence to this protocol is the responsibility of coaches, parents and wax technicians.
